- Also keep an eye out for villains wandering Main Street!
- Stroll through the shops to see all the amazing Halloweentime decor and displays.
- Grab one of the popular Poison Apple Mugs. They glow in the dark!
- Read the plaque under the Halloween Tree in Frontierland.
- Get Jack and Sally's autograph in New Orleans Square.
